The NGEN community consists of 3,000 members, 60% of which are media agencies and 40% are media owners. Each NGENer must have less than 5 years' experience in the media industry.

SIGN UP NOW

Follow the step-by-step instructions below to create your profile and register for an event.

Create your NGEN profile:

- 1) Go to our home page <u>www.ngen.org.au</u>
- 2) To create new profile click on Create NGEN Profile
- 3) Fill out detail as much as you can
- 4) Select your company in the drop down menu
- 5) Email address must be your work email address the system will not recognise personal email addresses
- 6) Please select NGENer as Registration Type
- 7) Submit your application

Your registration should be approved straight away and you can get started registering for sessions!

Register for an NGEN event:

- 1) To register for a session you must log in to your profile first
- 2) Go to the Event section
- 3) Chose your Event and click Register
- Your manager will get a notification that you are attending the event
- 5) Ensure you add the event to your diary so you don't forget!

WHAT TO EXPECT?

BEFORE A WORKSHOP:

- When you register for an event you will get a confirmation email presume you are in, but it will be 100% confirmed one week out.
- If you can no longer attend an event **DE-REGISTER** you need to give us 48 hours notice so we can ask someone else to come in your place it's easy, just log into your profile, click on upcoming events and deregister from the session. Otherwise, we note you down as a no show.

FACE TO FACE:

- Two working days BEFORE the event you will get an SMS with a 'Reminder' that you are attending.
- When you come to the session, BYO coffee and a pen and be on time!

WEBINARS

- You will get an email with the link details the day prior to the session
- Minimise distractions and lean into your session, our workshops are not passive so take part and stay engaged! Keep your camera on!

POST WORKSHOP:

- **Feedback** you will get an SMS or an email with a link to feedback. PLEASE fill out and SUBMIT this as it helps us fine tune our content!
- Reflect be sure to share your learnings with your team, and reflect on each session, hold yourself accountable and identify any small changes to embed your learning journey.
